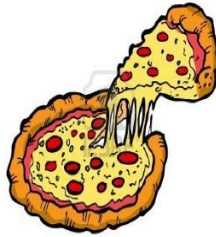


MOTHER/SON BOWLING & DADDY/DAUGHTER DANCE
