The Meeting was called to order by Beth Gornowich at 6:08 p.m., followed by an Opening Prayer led by Beth.

The Secretaries report was presented by Amanda Gentner. Michele Roggenbuck motioned to accept the report, Beth seconded the motion.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Beth, Mary Ramish was not present, but the report was still available. Deposits of \$41 from the apparel sale and \$2455 from the Road Rally were made in Oct/Nov. There are still outstanding transactions for the Drinking fountains and mulch. At this time the balance in the account is \$24,253.40. Amanda motioned to accept the report and Michele seconded the motion.

Old Business

1. Road Rally was once again a great success! 25 teams participated, and all 25 teams completed! A 50-50 raffle was held as well, Net profit for the event totaled \$2455. Thanks again to everyone involved to make this event possible!
2. Tech updates were given by Mr. Cavanaugh. At this time, he still has not heard from Cormac about the grant he applied for. It is expected that we will receive half of what we originally applied for. That would still cover some classroom devices such as a classroom iPad's and Chromebooks and computer hardware updates. Tami Nickrand started to update and do some cleaning of the computer lab. Thank you, Tami!
3. Teacher laptops- HSC approved the purchase the external drives for CD/DVD drive for the teachers laptops. Mr. Cavanaugh will get a headcount how many teachers would like and HSC will fund.
4. Fall Apparel sales profited \$41, HSC plans to go about a Spring apparel fundraiser as well, like it has been done in the past.
5. Fall Fundraiser: For the first time, OLLH families, and staff tried their hand in the Texas roadhouse Rolls fundraiser, and proved to be a great success! 50% profit for the Texas roadhouse rolls and butter and 10% for the gift cards will be returned to the HSC. The projected profit at this time is \$2,920! Estimated delivery is set for Tuesday, November 24th at 10:30 am, all sales must be picked up from 1-5pm.

New Business

6. Christmas Wreath Raffle. A very difficult decision was made NOT hold this event this year due to the complications of this year's Christmas Program. The Travel of Bethlehem Journey will take place with Zion schools included. Due to COVID restrictions and the combination event, HSC feels the wreaths is not able to be held this year.

7. Christmas Play/ Christmas Journey- Mr. Cavanaugh informed HSC that 2 adults per stations will be needed, along with possibly another volunteer to walk a sign across the name of the scene. Zion will provide half of the volunteers, OLLH the other half. Beth will reach out to Paula Wood and Andrea Rapson for more information regarding volunteers needed. Volunteers will also be needed for concession stands. Beth will follow up with HSC members after speaking with Mrs. Wood and Mrs. Rapson. Dress rehearsal is tentatively planned for December 1st 9-11am. Transportation for rehearsal has been requested by Mr. Cavanaugh, he has not been contacted back at this time. If any parents or High School students are interested in volunteering to help with the Christmas Journey, please, reach out to any HSC member, staff, or Mr. Cavanaugh.
8. Mask Fundraiser- Beth is going to check out where we are at with the parent volunteer. Possibly going home this upcoming week.
9. Yard sign- This subject will be revisited in spring. Most have been returned to the office.

Discussions and Comments:

- a. Mr. Cavanaugh voiced a concern that disposable masks were running low that are supplied to all students who forget theirs, or are used to enter the Building. Beth informed everyone that NFI will be donating! Thank you NFI for the Donation!
- b. A staff member discussed recess duty reimburse, as has been done in the past, HSC asks that all staff turns in recess duty hours and HSC will fund this. A special thank you to all teachers who continue to go above and beyond for their students through this difficult year!
